At 100' (34.5m) on deck, a waterline of 95'(30m), and a beam of just over 22'(6.8m), her ability to go to sea and stay at sea for extended passages is unmatched by any other similar vessel.

She is superbly designed with redundant systems featuring hand-built continuous duty engines with exceptional strength and mechanical art ensconced in dedicated mechanical rooms. Custom environmental systems take her and her passengers from the frozen Bering Sea to the warmth of Southern climes.

HULL LAYOUT

The layout of this spectacular yacht provides four levels of operating and living spaces that superlatives cannot describe. The hallmark fit and finish found in all Marlow Yachts is again in evidence in this world cruiser with a number of innovative concepts designed especially for rugged, long-range passages.

The mechanical and electrical systems are segregated in system-specific rooms for easy access and maintenance and to provide a machinery space with full headroom and walk-around ability. 
The electrical system was created for use in almost every location in the world. While highly complex, the execution of the design and expertise in installation allows for precise and trouble-free operation.

The climate control system is fully custom-built for the expected rigors of the wide-ranging capability of the yacht, ensuring comfortable levels whether in the frigid north or the equatorial regions of the world.

The crew quarters aft of the machinery space is a completely self-contained living area with bunks, galley, head and stall shower, and plenty of personal storage space.




MARLOW MAGICAL TEAK


Asia Boating Awards: Marlow-Norsemen received the award for "Green" Maritime Company of the Year with Michael Huang accepting the award for the company.
